MISSION & VISION


Enhancing education for students of Hood River County School District by providing financial support for programs, services, and scholarships.

- PROGRAM OVERVIEW -

The Hood River County Education Foundation is an independent 501(c)3 nonprofit organization founded in 1991 that has been supporting the students, teachers and staff of the Hood River County School District for over 25 years. Through the generous donations of individuals and businesses in our community, as well as by soliciting grants from outside organizations, the Education Foundation has funded many educational initiatives, including our flagship programs:

SCHOLARSHIPS:

The Education Foundation currently has 33 scholarship funds to assist Hood River Valley High School graduates attending college or technical schools. More than 675 students have received scholarships through the Foundation.

INNOVATIVE TEACHING GRANTS By awarding grants for creative classroom projects or materials that fall outside the school

district budget, teachers and staff can offer students unique and valuable learning experiences. THE OPPORTUNITY CAMPAIGN:

Our current fundraising initiative fills the gap left by decreased state funding by subsidizing fees for low-income kids to participate in middle school sports and after-school activities.
